



"THE BEST WAY TO HANDLE AN AWKWARD MESS"

TODAY'S PASSAGE

1 Samuel 25:9-13 ESV... When David's young men came, they said all this to Nabal in the name of David, and then they waited. 10 And Nabal answered David's servants, "Who is David? Who is the son of Jesse? There are many servants these days who are breaking away from their masters. 11 Shall I take my bread and my water and my meat that I have killed for my shearers and give it to men who come from I do not know where?" 12 So David's young men turned away and came back and told him all this. 13 And David said to his men, "Every man strap on his sword!" And every man of them strapped on his sword. David also strapped on his sword. And about four hundred men went up after David, while two hundred remained with the baggage.

DAVID ON THE RUN

- David was often on the run from King Saul.
- David reached out to Nabal for food and assistance... 1 Samuel 25:5-8

NABAL'S LESS THAN GRACIOUS RESPONSE

- Nabal flat out refuses David's request for assistance... 1 Samuel 25:9-13
- David is so offended, he's ready to slaughter Nabal... 1 Samuel 25:13
- Things were about to go from "awkward" to "catastrophic".
- KEY: The best way to handle an awkward mess is always with a godly response!

ABIGAIL'S GODLY RESPONSE: KEYS TO CLEANING UP AN AWKWARD MESS

- Abigail is approachable & advisable ... Nabal was not ... 1 Samuel 25:14-17; Prov. 12:15
- Abigail is <u>decisive</u> and <u>discerning</u>... 1 Samuel 25:18-20
- Abigail is <u>humble</u> & <u>contrite</u>... 1 Samuel 25:23
- Abigail is honest and objective. . . 1 Samuel 25:25
- Abigail is apologetic & repentant... 1 Samuel 25:27-28; Prov. 28:13; 15:1.
- Abigail is <u>spiritually perspective</u>... 1 Samuel 25:28-31

A CATASTROPHIC MESS AVOIDED

- Because of Abigail, David relents from his anger... 1 Samuel 25:32-35
- God himself avenges David... 1 Samuel 25:39
- It's tragic when Christians can't resolve awkward messes on their own... 1 Cor. 6:1
- KEY: The best way to handle an awkward mess is always with a godly response!
